Pursuant to 104 F.I. of the State of New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission's Rules and Regulations, Koch Exploration Company hereby applies for an unorthodox location for the Dryden #1-E, a Dakota Basin Well located 1300' FNL and 555' FEL (NE/4NE/4) Section 28-T28N-R8W, San Juan County, New Mexico based upon topographic reasons.

Originally the well was staked at 1600' FNL and 1900' FEL but due to a large wash, the proposed well location was moved to the existing footage as set forth above.

This application for unorthodox location is being sent in triplicate along with a plat that shows the ownership of all leases offsetting the spacing unit for which the unorthodox location is being sought as well as all wells completed thereon. Also attached is a topographic map and waivers from all offset operators.




