Reference is made to your letter, dated November 2, 1988, concerning the subject well. Amoco intends to recomplete this well to the Gallup producing horizon, however the cost of the physical operation in the current economic environment cannot be justified. Therefore, Amoco respectfully requests your approval to temporarily abandon this well in such a fashion that it can be re-entered in the future for a Gallup recompletion. The currently open perforations and proposed temporary abandonment procedure, in brief, is shown below. We estimate that the temporary abandonment operations can be completed by the end of February, 1989.

Open Perfs - 5916'-5922' 5958'-5998'

Procedure:

Install bridge plug +-5900'; cap with 5 sacks cement using dump bailer or 25 sacks if spotted with tubing string; fill with conditioned, non-corrosive fluid; test casing and shut-in at the surface.
