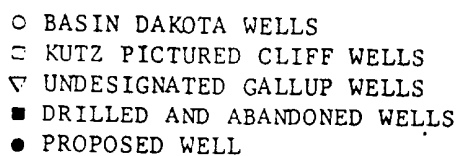

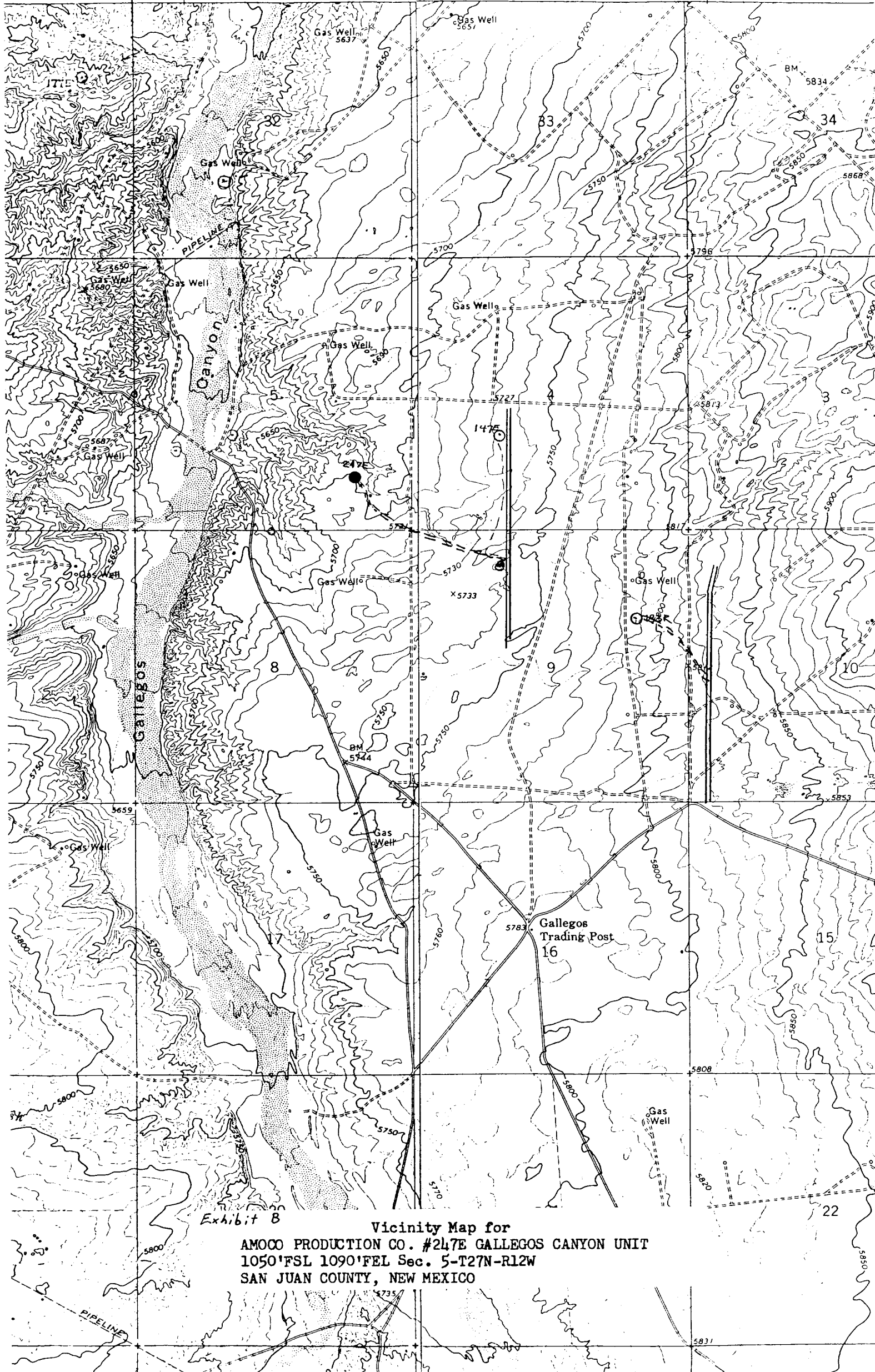


Exhibit B
