This is a request for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Basin Dakota pool.


It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company's Huerfano Unit #105E at 1520' from the South line and 420' from the West line of Section 29, T-27-N, R-10-W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Extremely rough terrain in the form of steep cliffs in the Southwest corner of this section makes it impossible to build an orthodox gas well location.




