

Dear Mr. O'Hare:

Reference is made to your application dated October 5, 1990 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Marron W.N. Federal Com Well No. 9 to be located 1760 feet from the North line and 360 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 27, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The N/2 of said Section 27 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
