Approval to install a permanent gas sales line, from the existing Navajo "AA" No. 2 well to ElPaso's "6-F" Line, is requested (see attached plat).

This area is covered by a NAPI blanket archeological survey. # 79-NM-175  
The line placement has been approved by Mr. Henry Nakai with the NAPI.

- Materials will be wrapped steel line pipe tested to 1000 psi for 30 minutes.
- The working pressure of the pipeline will be ≈ 300 psi.
- Length of pipeline will be ≈ 1250'.
- All road crossings will be marked and all pipe buried to a minimum depth of 4'.
- THE PIPELINE WILL BE 45' FROM CENTERLINE OF ROAD, OUTSIDE EXISTING ROAD R.O.W.
