1) Federal 24-31, sec. 31, T. 27 N., R. 11 W., Lease NM-03523

A plan to lay 2345' of gas pipeline to an existing pipeline connection in the southeast quarter of section 31 has been submitted and approved. Dominion believes that water production from the Federal 24-31 may be significant and could determine the commerciality of the project. Dominion is currently making applications with the Navahos, the EPA, BLM, and state for a water injection well in the SE/4 SE/4 of section 32-27N-11W which will serve the Federal 24-31 and other nearby Dominion operated wells including some 2003 planned wells in sections 25, 26, and 27 of 27N-12W. Based on the time it took to receive Navaho approval on the applications to drill in sections 25, 26, and 27 of 27N-11W (approximately 1 year), an extension of 1 year is requested for proceeding with the Federal 24-31 pipeline, so that Dominion can conclude permitting of the water injection well.
