The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle the following pools and acreage within Section 6, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

M. N. Galt "B" No. 1R

Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas 71629) Pools

API No. 30-045-29136)
SW/4 Dedication

M. N. Galt "B" No. 1Y
Basin-Dakota (Prorated Gas 71599) Pool

Production shall be determined by separately metering the production from the M. N. Galt "B" No. 1Y and determining the M. N. Galt "B" No. 1R production by the subtraction method. **Compressor fuel gas usage shall be allocated according to well production rates.** Water and Oil production shall not be commingled.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled natural gas production shall be delivered to a gas sales meter located on the lease.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Aztec District Office of the Division upon implementation of commingling operations.
