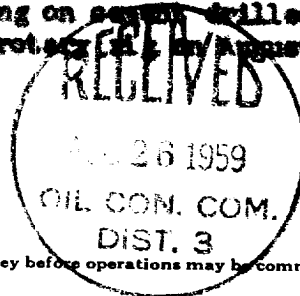

DETAILS OF WORK

On August 11, 1959, 4-1/2 inch casing was set at 6541 feet with 2 stage cement tool at 2159'. Cemented first stage with 100 sacks 6% gal cement containing 1-1/2 pounds Tuf-Plug per sack, followed by 100 sacks Neat cement. Good returns throughout. Tested with 3000 psi which held with no indication of pressure drop. Cemented second stage with 250 sacks 4% gal cement. Good returns throughout. Tested with 3000 psi which held with no indication of pressure drop. After waiting on cement drilled second stage cement tool and cleaned out to 6499'. Released rotary bit on August 12, 1959.
