Perforate Pictured Cliffs formation. Sand-water frac with 10,000 gallons water, 10,000 lbs. sand. Run 1" tubing to 2130'. The proration unit assigned is the SW 1/4 and consists of 160 acres.

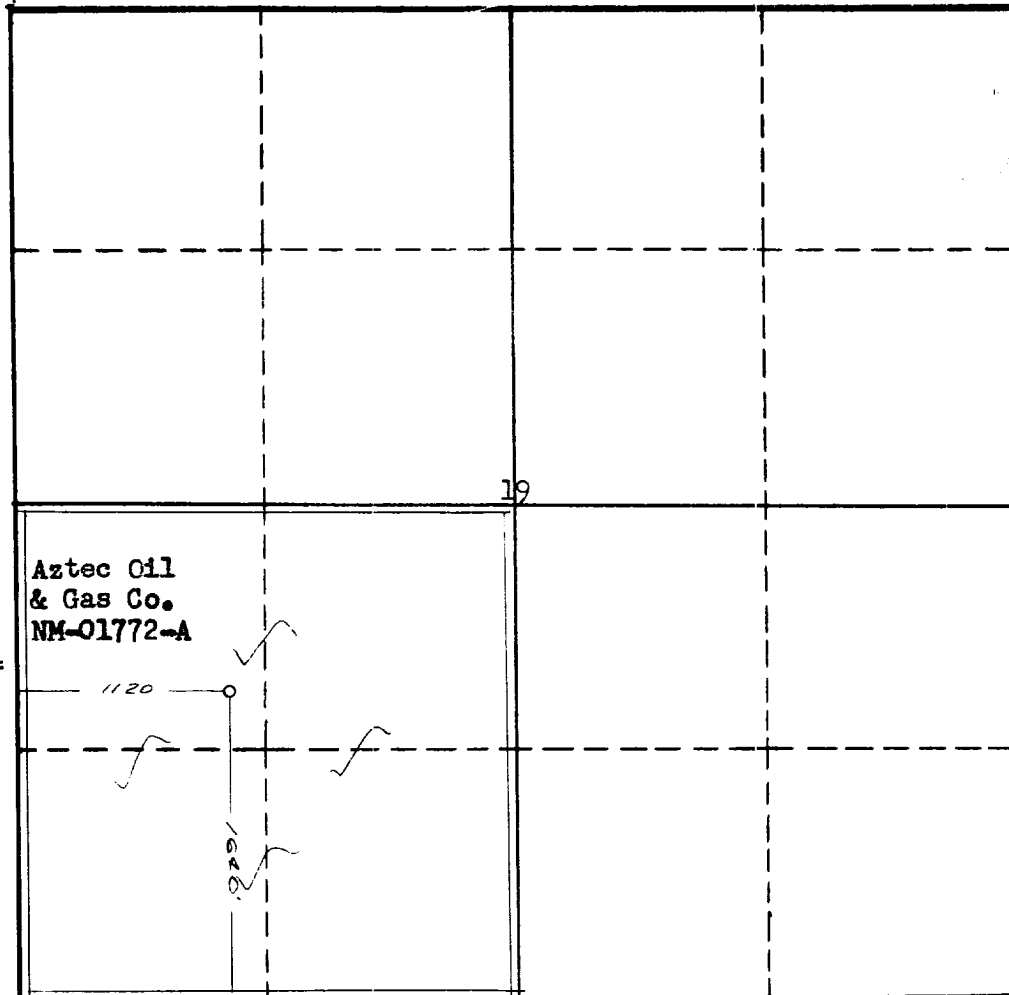
