Exhibit B: Results of multiple completion on Well
 (attached) - Reservoir Report and Log Form

1. The following information should be given for each sample: (a) date and time of day; (b) location, including exact date of starting day; (c) name of person or persons who collected the sample; (d) give subsurface locations and measured and/or vertical depths for all markers and zones pertinent to the sample.

Set a 4-1/2" Baker Model "D" packer at 1900'. On January 11, 1973, perforated Fruitland formation 1760-64 and 1771-82 with 2 SPW. Spotted 500 gallons 15% HCl and displaced. Swabbed 10 barrels water and the well kicked off. Installed 3/4" choke and flowed 3 hours. Installed BOP and shut in 34 hours with CPC 720. On January 15, 1973 sand-water fraced with 25,000 gallons treated water (1% KCl and 10 pounds Gel per 1000 gallons water), 15,000 pounds 10-20 and 10,000 pounds 8-12 sand. Treating pressures: Maximum 2250 psi, minimum 2100 psi, average 2200 psi. AIR 42.5 BPM.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
