A rig will be moved on this well March 17, 1989, and the two zones will be commingled as per the above administrative order. We recommend production allocation as follows:

This allocation is based on recent actual producing rates of each zone of 36 MCFD and trace of oil from the Gallup, and 18 MCFD and trace of oil from the Dakota.
