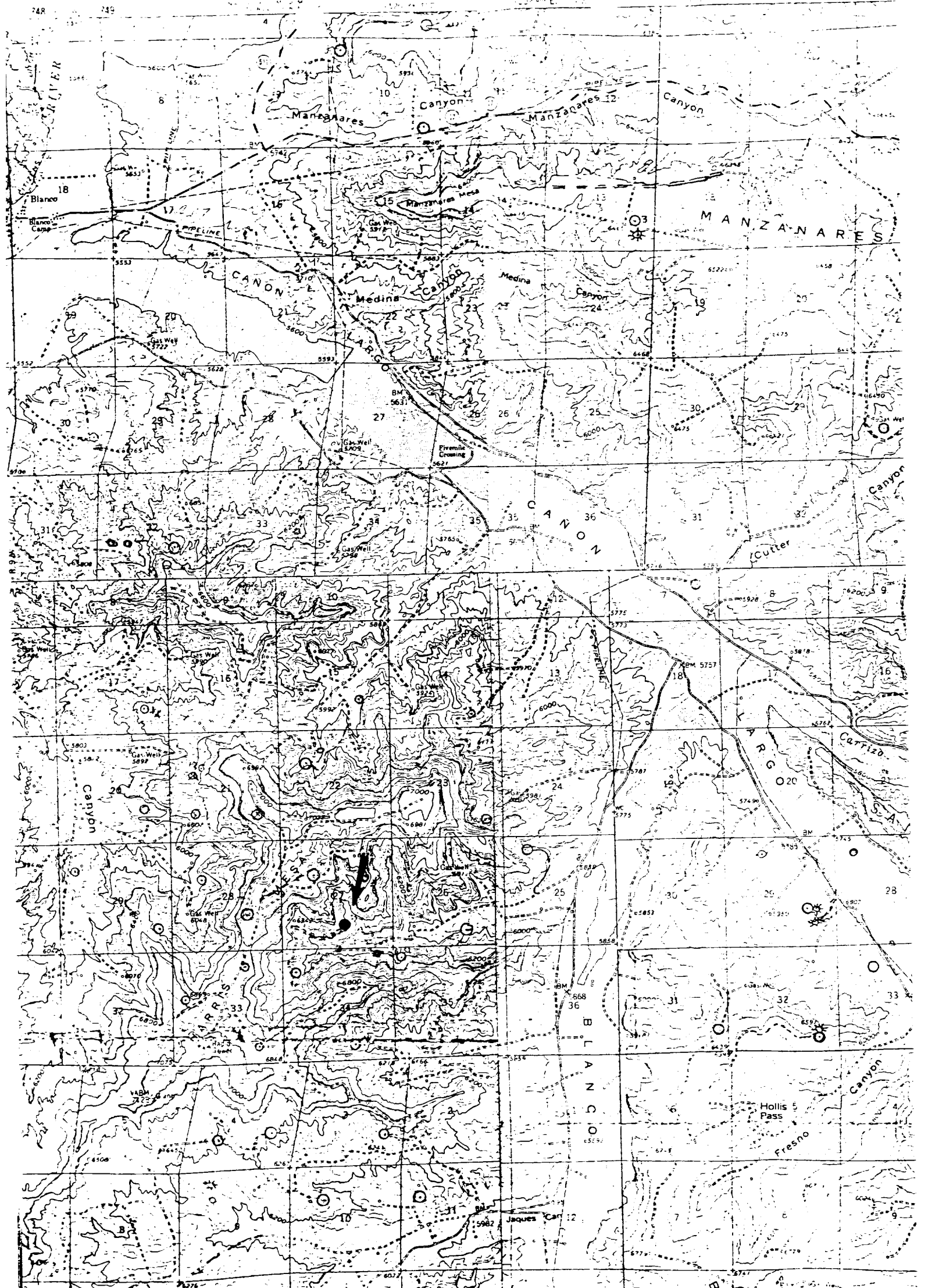


TENNECO OIL COMPANY #7A STOREY "C" (LS)
