E/2 of Section 29

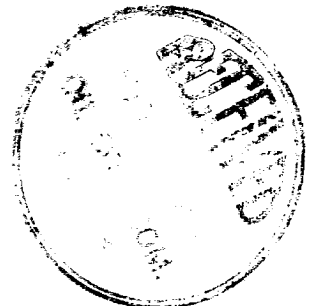

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 1 (b), Section 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-128-D, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 314.42 acres.
