DETAILS OF WORK

Well spudded Sept. 17, 1951.

On Sept. 18, 10-3/4" casing landed at 100' with 100 sacks cement. Cement circulated to surface. Set 24 hours.

Sept. 19, drilled plug, tested casing and water shut off with 600 lbs. pressure 30 minutes. No drop in pressure.

Drilling resumed.
