DETAILS OF WORK

Total depth 6245' - set 4-1/2" casing at 6244' and cemented first stage with 400 sacks 6 percent gel cement containing 4-1/2 pounds of plug per sack, followed by 100 sacks neat cement. Tested 4-1/2" casing with 3000 psi for 15 minutes which held ok. Cemented second stage at 2660' with 400 sacks 6 percent gel cement. Tested 4-1/2" casing with 3000 psi for 15 minutes which held with no indication of pressure drop. Received good circulation throughout both stages.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
