R & G Drilling Company, Inc. is presently planning a dual completion of its R & G No. 25 (SF 078673) located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, T28N, R11W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

This well is to be dually completed in the Fruitland formation and in the Pictured Cliffs formation. So far as is known, this well is not within the boundaries of any designated pool. The dual completion will be a normal tubing annulus completion with a packer separating the producing zones, with a side door valve installation on the tubing for bottom hole pressure tests.


Upon completion and the running of initial potential and packer leakage tests, administrative approval by the Oil Conservation Commission will be requested.
