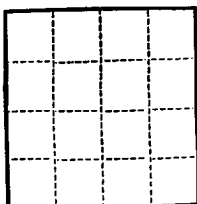

## DETAILS OF WORK

Run 149 jts. 5 1/2" 15.50 J-55 casing set from 3.40' to 3249.05'. Cemented 1st stage with 225 sacks 50-50 pozmix with 2% CaCl<sub>2</sub>. Displaced plug with water. Plug down at 10:30 PM 9-16-60 with 2000#. WOC 4 hours and opened stage collar. Circulated 1/4 hour. Pumped in 10 BW. Cemented 2nd stage with 300 sacks 50-50 pozmix with 2% CaCl<sub>2</sub>. Displaced plug with water. Closed stage collar at 3:45 AM 9-17-60.
