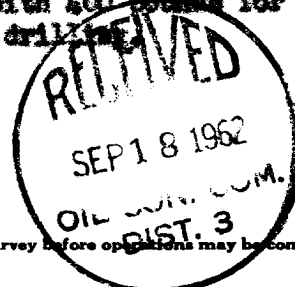
The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 5899 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

The above well was spudded on September 7, 1962 and drilled to a depth of 214'. 8-5/8" casing was set at 213' with 180 sacks Incon cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Circulated approximately 40 sacks.

After waiting on cement to set tested 8-5/8" casing with 400 pounds for 30 minutes. Test ok. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 214' and resumed drilling.
