DETAILS OF WORK

On November 26, 1956, 5-1/2" casing was landed at 6400' and cemented with 300 sacks cement. After waiting on cement for 48 hours, casing and water shut off were tested with 1100 pounds pressure for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Completion operations were resumed.
