1. Spot cement inside 4½" casing from 5725' to 5272'. Gallup Top @ 5322'.
2. Perforate 4½" casing @ 2630' & spot cement from 2630' to 2530' inside & outside casing. Mesa Verde Top @ 2580'.
3. Perforate 4½" casing @ 1695' & spot cement from 1695' to 1280' inside & outside casing. Pictured Cliff Top @ 1645' & Fruitland Top @ 1330'.
4. Perforate 4½" casing @ 268' & circulate cement to surface. Ojo Alamo Top @ 218'.
5. Erect Dry Hole Marker, and restore location.

Note: Mud will be spotted between all plugs.

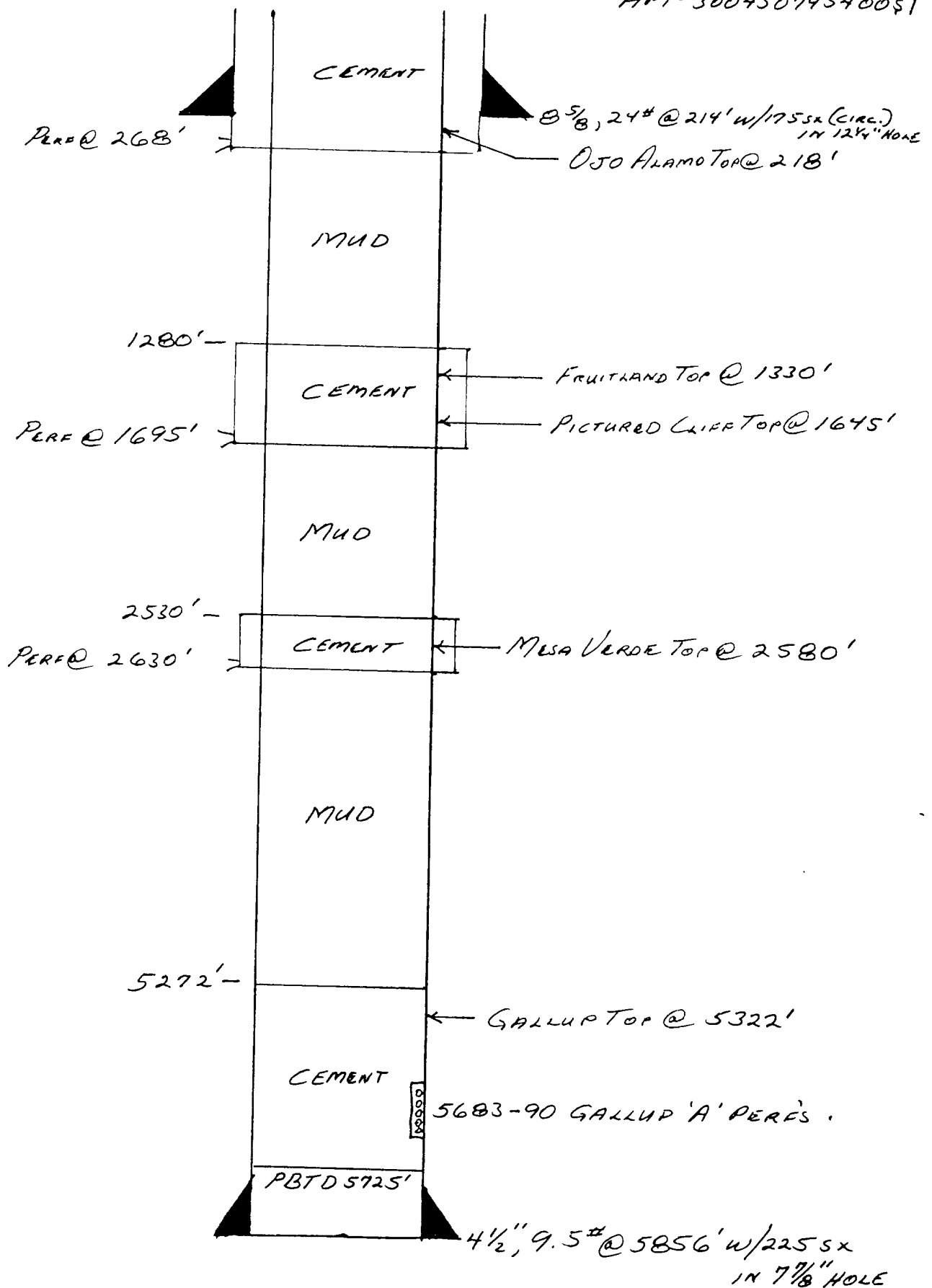
