We propose to return the subject well to water injection and plan to plug back from the Gallup B zone by setting a bridge plug at 5770' and dumping one sack of cement on the plug. A packer will be set at about 5580' and water will be injected down 2-3/8" tubing into the Gallup A" zone at 5726-33'.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
