Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of four non-standard locations in the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, as follows:

Gallegos Canyon Unit-PC Well No. 105, located 210 feet from the South line and 600 feet from the East line of Section 12, Township 28 North, Range 13 West, NMPM;

Gallegos Canyon Unit-PC Well No. 122, located 605 feet from the North line and 535 feet from the West line of Section 18, Township 28 North, Range 12 West, NMPM;

Gallegos Canyon Unit-PC Well No. 131, located 600 feet from the North line and 780 feet from the West line of Section 17, Township 28 North, Range 12 West, NMPM; and

Gallegos Canyon Unit-PC Well No. 251, located 660 feet from the North line and 2260 feet from the West line of Section 24, Township 28 North, Range 12 West, NMPM.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104 F of the Commission Rules and Regulations, the above-described unorthodox locations are hereby approved.
