Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 129.60-acre mon-standard gas proration unit in the West Kutz-Fictured Cliffs Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

## Township 28 North, Flange 12 West, NMPM W/2 of Fractional Section 7

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 32, located 990 feet from the South line and 650 feet from the West line of fractional Section 7, Township 28 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 6, Section (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-566, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 12%. 60 acres.
