Gentlemen:

We are returning two copies of Federal Notice of Intention to Drill for your #1 Pan Am Navajo well located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7-26N-14W.

You have not indicated on the Notice the quantity of cement to be used on either the surface or production casing. Our rules require that cement be circulated on the surface casing and while there are no specific rules for the amount of cement to be used on the production casing, in the area of you well I would recommend a minimum of 200 sacks to be used. Please amend the forms and return to this office.
