
Copies of the above instruments are being forwarded to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for their information.

ALLEGED ATTEMPT TO OBTAIN  
PASSPORT FOR TRIP TO EUROPE

On June 8, 1964, the New York Office received a letter from James Earl Ray, dated June 7, 1964, in which he requested a passport for a trip to Europe. The letter stated that he was a U.S. citizen and was currently residing in New York City. He stated that he was planning to travel to Europe for business purposes and requested that a passport be issued to him as soon as possible. The letter also stated that he had been in contact with a person named "John" who had advised him to contact the New York Office for assistance in obtaining a passport.

The New York Office has advised the Bureau that it is currently reviewing the request and will report the results of its investigation to the Bureau as soon as possible.
