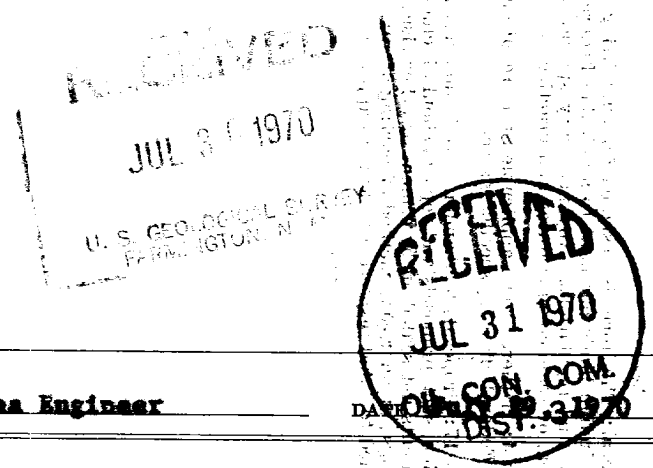

The 4-1/2" casing was set at 6381' with DV tools at 4615' and 1989'. The first stage was cemented with 450 sacks Type "C" with 6X Gel and 2 pounds medium Tuf Plug followed by 100 sacks Type "C" Neat. The second stage was cemented with 650 sacks Type "C" with 6X Gel and 2 pounds medium Tuf Plug and 50 sacks Type "C" Neat. Cemented third stage with 450 sacks Type "C" with 6X Gel and 2 pounds medium Tuf Plug followed by 50 sacks Neat. Cement circulated on all stages.

Instructions
