LOCATION: 1,570' FSL & 1,660' FWL, Sec. 23, T28N, R11W, Unit K, San Juan Co., NM

#1 Existing Roads:

- A. Proposed well site as staked. (Actual staking should include two each 200-foot directional reference stakes).

See attached survey plat.

- B. Route and distance from nearest town and locatable reference point to where well access route leaves main road.

South from Bloomfield, NM, for 2 miles, turn left on Gasoline Plant Road for approximately 1-1/4 miles. Turn right through Sec. 24, 26, turn right into Sec. 23. See map Diagram "A" color coded RED.

- C. Access road(s) to location color-coded or labeled.

See map Diagram "A" color coded GREEN.

- D. If exploratory well, all existing roads within a 3-mile radius (including type of surface, conditions, etc.).

- E. If development well, all existing roads within a 1-mile radius of well site.

- F. Plans for improvement and/or maintenance of existing roads.

All new road is center line flagged with Hot Blue and Orange flagging material, and walked 40' on each side by Archeologists from San Juan College, Farmington, NM.
