

THE APPLICATION OF SUPRON ENERGY  
CORPORATION FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2921

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A Supron Energy Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on September 5, 1981, for permission to dually complete its Angel Peak "B" Well No. 25-E located in Unit F of Section 24, Township 28 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Chacra Formation and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

NOW, on this 28th day of September, 1981, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rule and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Supron Energy Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Angel Peak "B" Well No. 25-E located in Unit F of Section 24, Township 28 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Chacra Formation and the Basin-Dakota Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.




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PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
