Reference is made to your application for amendment of Administrative Order NSL-1165 for two non-standard Gallegos Canyon Unit Well locations, Basin Dakota Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, as follows:

Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 184E to be located 1435 feet from the South line and 1590 feet from the East line of Section 28, T-28-N, R-12-W, and the

Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 185E to be located 600 feet from the North line and 515 feet from the East line of Section 33, Township 28 North, Range 12 West.
