DV Collar to be run below Mesa Verde and cement to bottom of 8-5/8" surface casing.

Propose to drill this infill well in order to gain optimum gas recovery from the Basin Dakota field. Samples will be taken at 20' intervals from 4500' to TD. No cores or DST's are planned. Logs will be run from surface casing to TD. Prospective zones will be perforated and fractured. Blowout preventer equipment will be as indicated on the attached exhibit, and will be tested at regular intervals. Necessary steps will be taken to protect the environment.

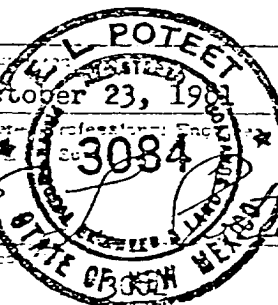

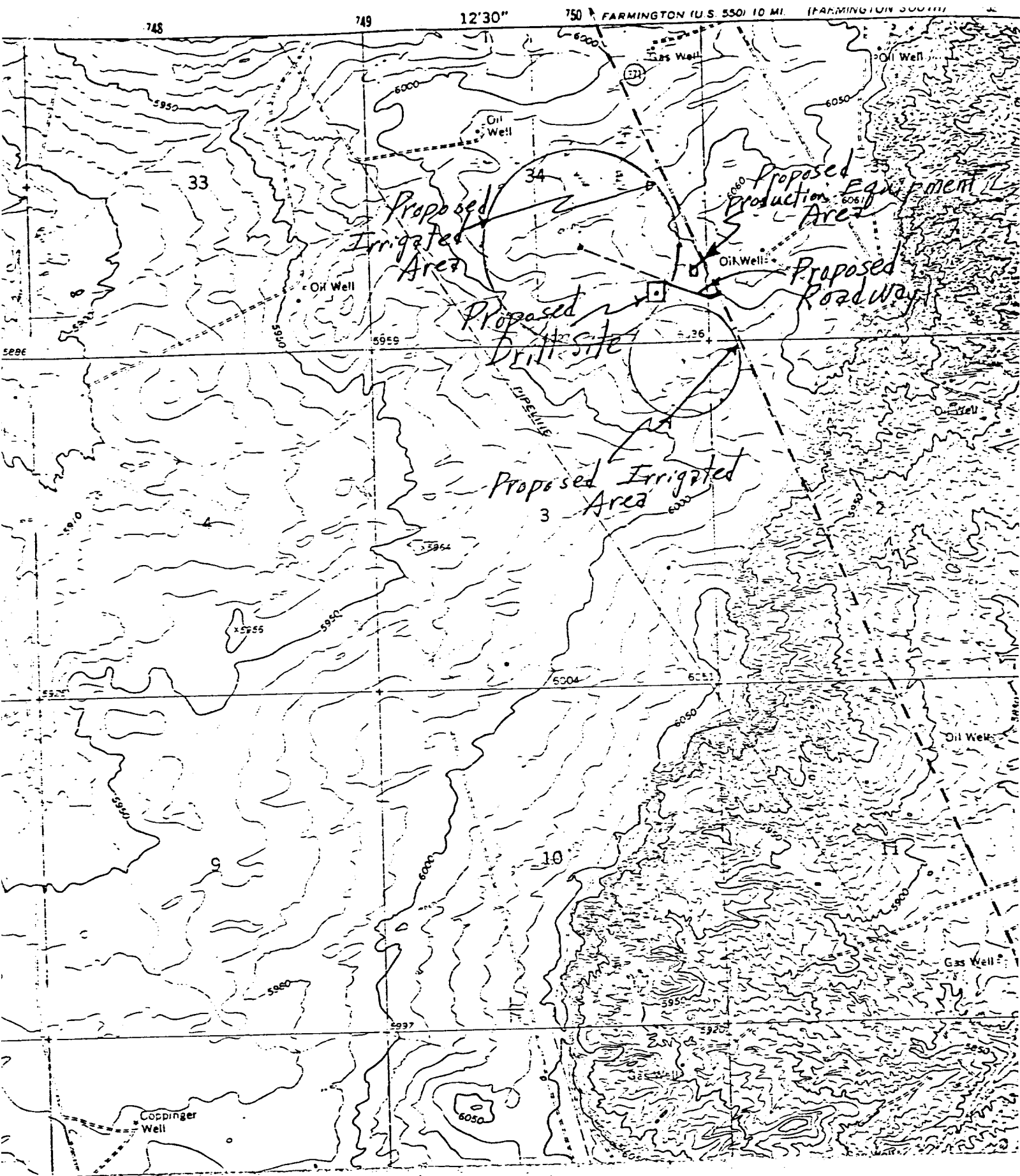

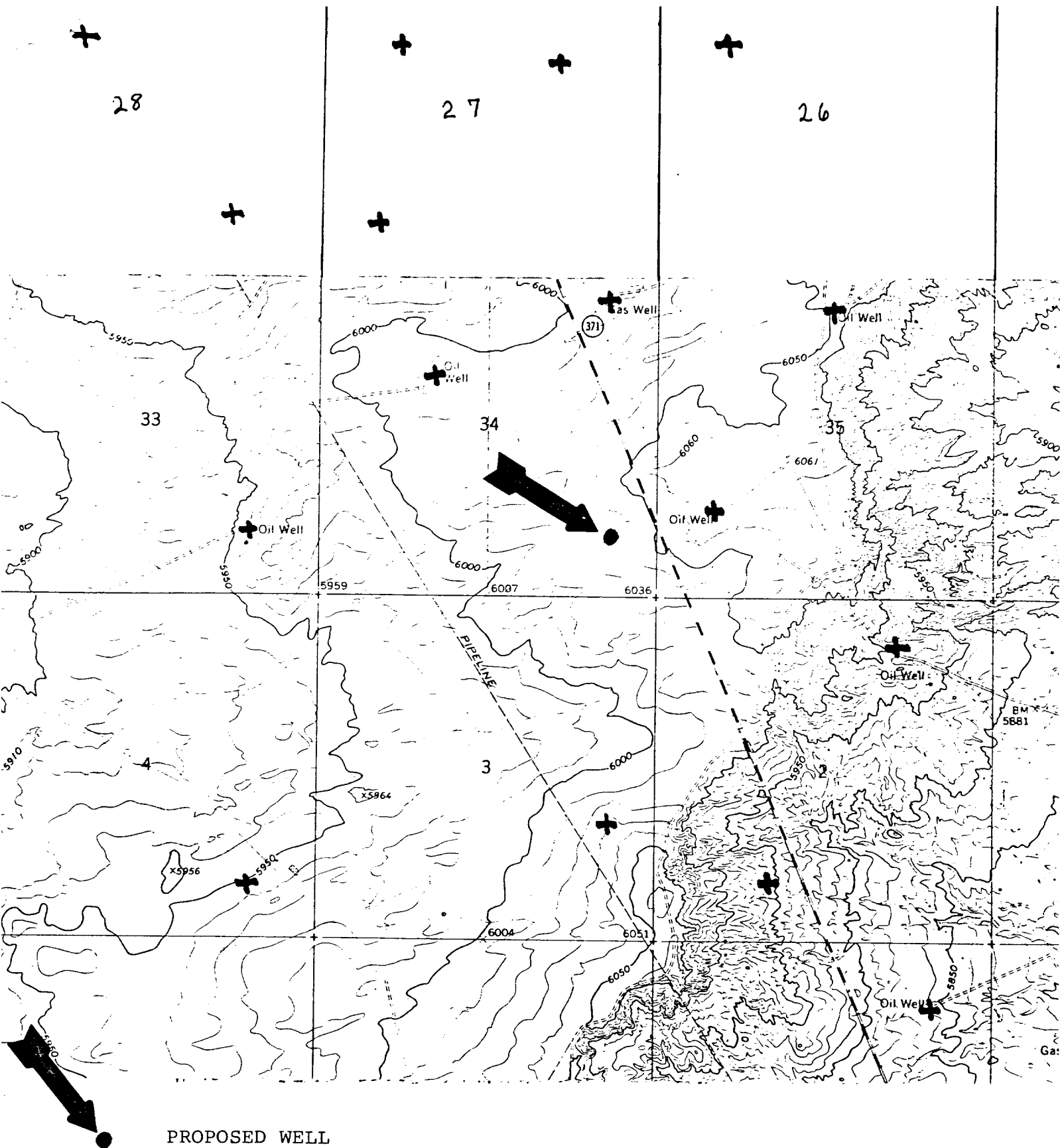
