## Recompletion

Gallegos Canyon Unit #83E Amoco WI 75% Gallup Recompletion

#### Purpose:

The following procedure plugs the Dakota formation which is unable to produce at economic rates and recomplete the Gallup formation.

### **Suggested Procedure:**

- 1. Set Cement Retainer @ 6,000' (50 ft above top perf).
- 2. Plug Dakota zone (squeeze Dakota perfs 6084-92, 6150-88) with approx. 57 sx Cement (2 x's behind pipe, 1.5 x's in pipe)
- 3. Spot cement plug 50 ' above retainer to 5,950' with 5 sx.
- 4. Tag for plug back depth.
- 5. Hydraulically pressure test Casing to 500 psi.
- 6. Perf Gallup 5,533-65.
- 6. Fracture stimulate Gallup formation with 50,000 # 20/40 Sand (Foam).
- 7. Land production string.
- 5. Flow test well.
