Please reference your letters of August 30, 1989, and December 20, 1989, regarding participating area applications in the Gallegos Canyon Unit. Amoco has reviewed the subject letters and forwarded those regarding sub-operated wells to BHP Petroleum, for their handling. As you are aware, BHP Petroleum is the sub-operator of several horizons in Gallegos Canyon Unit and will submit their response directly to you. However, two of the wells, the GCU 214E and 217E Gallup, are operated by Amoco and are addressed in this letter.

The two referenced wells, GCU Gallup Well Nos. 214E and 217E, are presently shut-in due to marginal production. Test results from the wells are 2 BOPD and 1 BOPD for the 214E and 217E, respectively. These rates are insufficient to justify any remedial work at the present time. Therefore, Amoco requests approval of temporary shut-in status on the two subject wells.
