The Upper Fruitland Coal was completed starting on 2/1/00 as follows: Set RBP at 1,770' to isolate lower Fruitland Coal. Perforated 1,727'-30', 1,687'-89', 1,649'-51', 1,620'-22' & 1,592'-94' with 4 JSPP. Acidized perforations with 500 gals 15% HCL acid and 75 ball sealers. Frac with 33,988 gals 700 foam. 1,400 lbs. 40/70 sd & 50,000 lbs 20/40 sand. Pulled RBP at 1,770'. The Upper & Lower Fruitland Coals were commingled and the well return to production 2/4/00.
