PROJECT DESCRIPTION

GENERAL

Roddy Production Company, Inc. proposes to construct a pipeline for the purpose of transporting natural gas from the Lucerne Federal #1 and Lucerne Federal #2 located in the NW/NW Section 17 T28N R11W to a proposed compressor site located in NW/SW Section 17 T28N R11W. The compressor will discharge into an existing line at this point presently transporting gas from the Lucerne Federal #3 and Lucerne Federal #5 to a CDP located on El Paso Natural Gas line #6K. All four wells will then be tied into the suction side of the compressor.

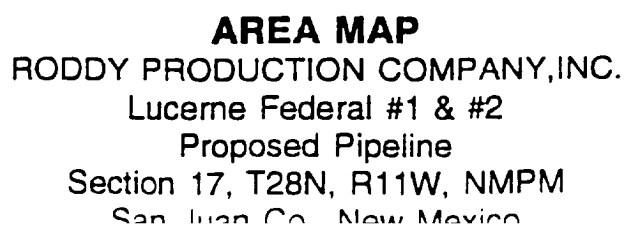
PIPELINE

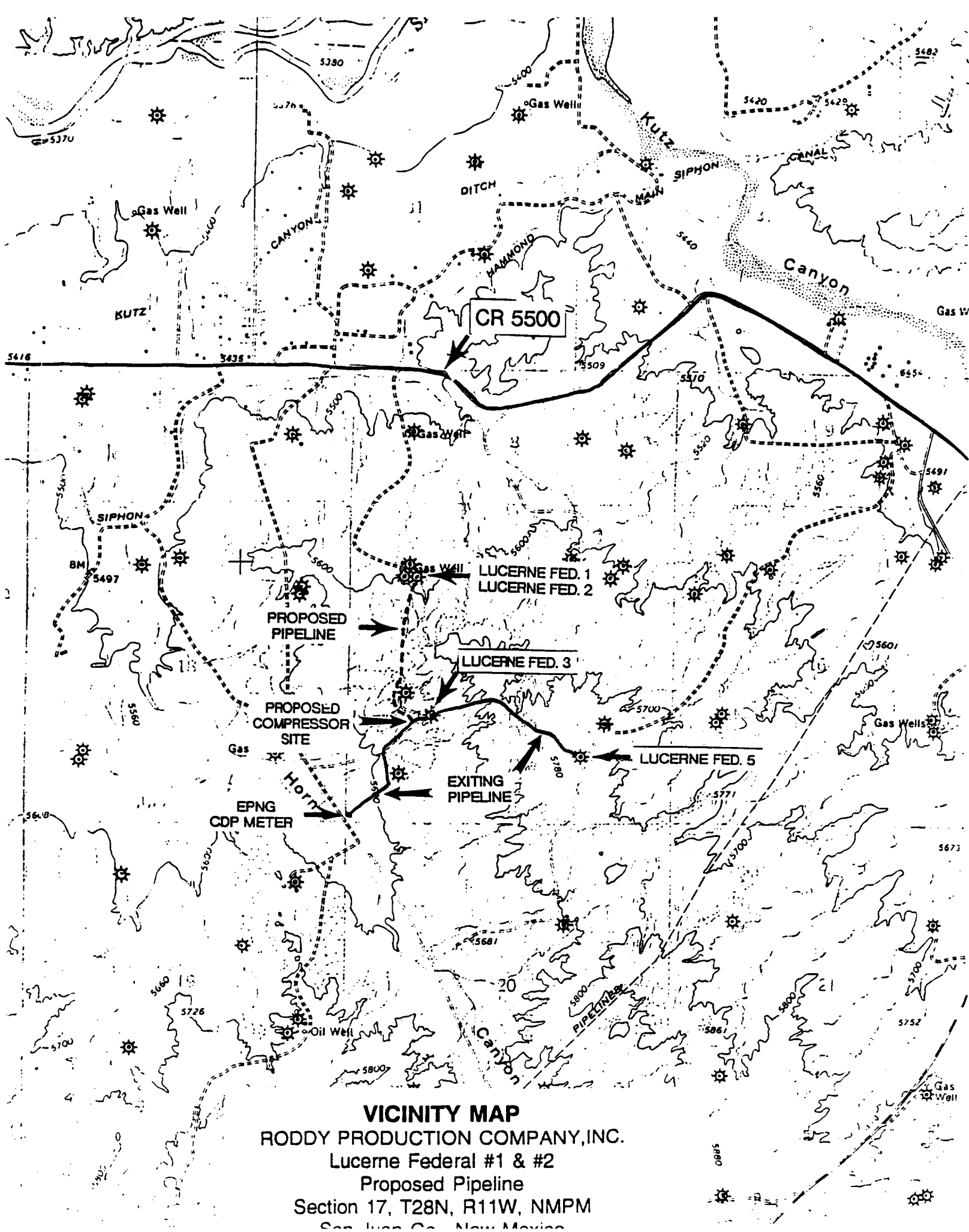
The proposed pipeline will be 2746' in length with a 30' right-of-way width. The proposed route is entirely on BLM surface and will follow existing trails or roads thus minimizing the additional disturbance. A cultural inventory survey was conducted on October 26, 1995 by Moore Anthropological Services. A copy of the Technical Report No. 95-029 has been sent to the BLM.

The maximum operating pressure of the line will be 500 psig with an anticipated normal operating pressure below 150 psig. The pipeline will be constructed of either 3" coated steel pipe or 3" coated aluminum pipe both with a maximum operating pressure in excess of 800 psig. Once installed the line will be tested to a minimum of 500 psig.

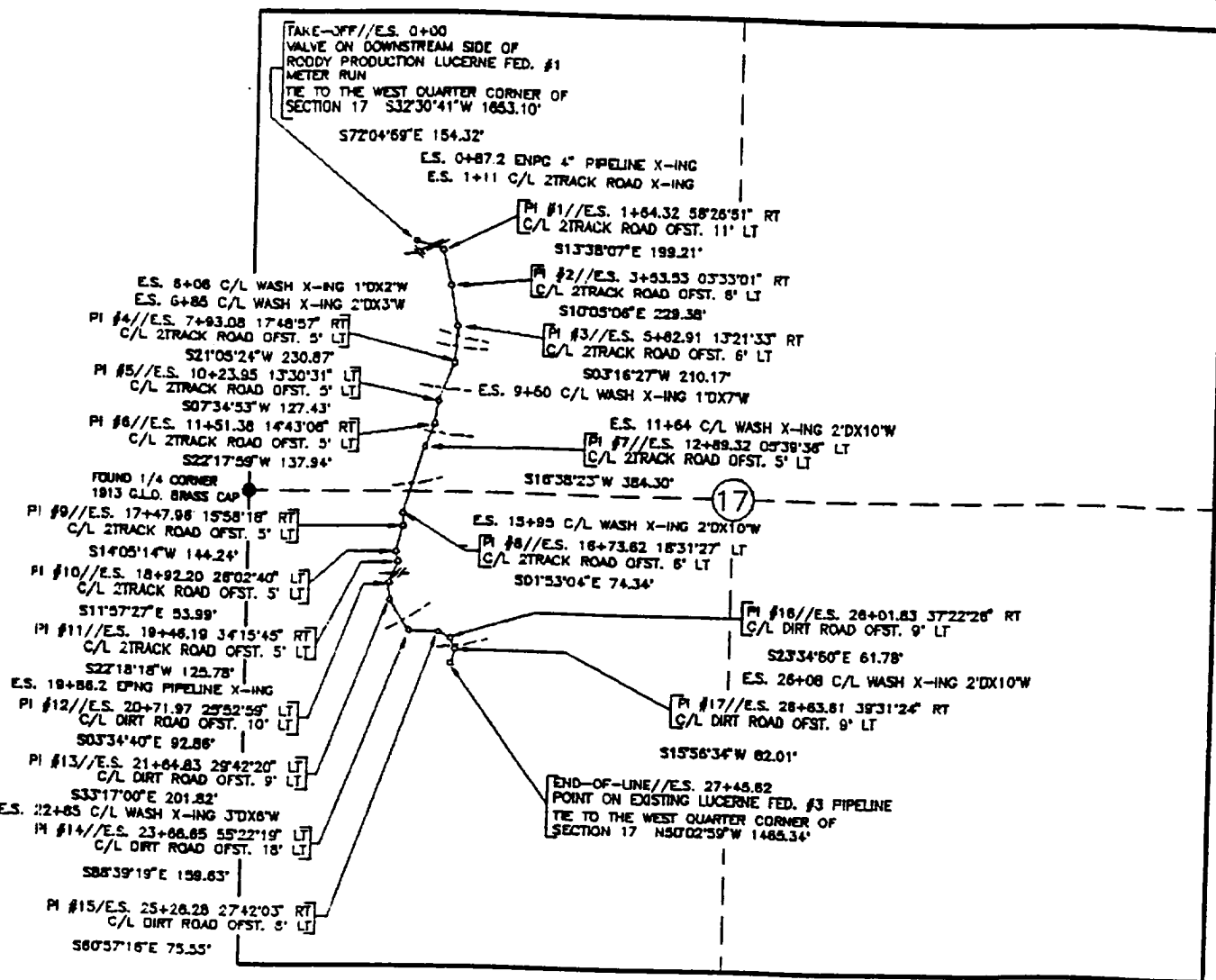
COMPRESSOR SITE

A compressor pad of 50' x 100' is proposed and will be constructed such that the long side of the pad overlays the existing Lucerne Federal #3 pipeline right-of-way. The cultural inventory survey conducted on August 4, 1994 by Moore Anthropological Research (Technical Report No. 94-014B) surveyed a 40' right-of-way and an additional 50' buffer on each side. The proposed compressor pad will be contained within the previously surveyed right-of-way and buffer. No cultural resources were found in the area of the proposed site by the previous survey.





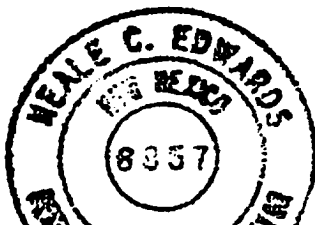
LUCERNE FEDERAL #1 & #2 PIPELINE SURVEY

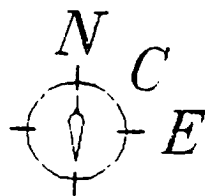
