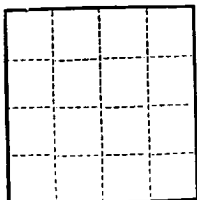

DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill & dual complete a well in the Dakota formation & Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the Pictured Cliffs & set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the middle of the Greenhorn formation & 7" liner will be set. Mud circulation will be used thru the Dakota formation & production liner will be set. Possible productive intervals will be perforated & fractured. Est. T. D. 8050'.

Casing Program:

- 13 3/8" at 300' w/450 sks. cement circulated to surface.
- 9 5/8" at 3653' w/860 sks. cement circulated to surface
- 7" at 7650' w/600 sks. cement.
- 5" at 8050' w/200 sks. cement.

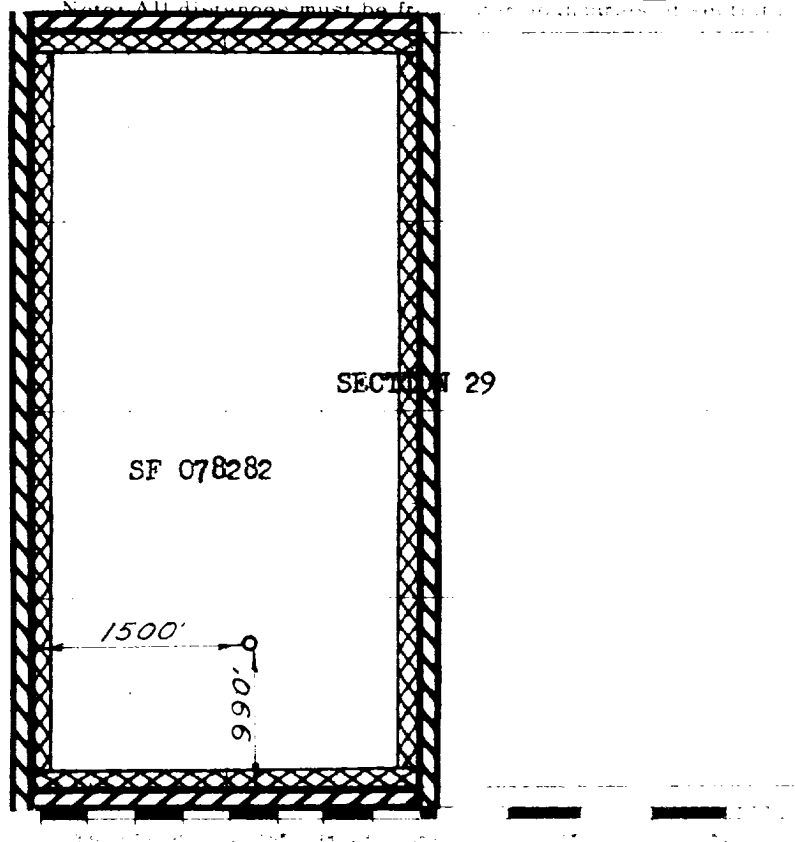
