Section 25: E/2 (fractional)


It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Well No. 42-25, located 1450 feet from the North line and 1070 feet from the East line of said Section 25.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 1 (b), Section 15 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-128-D, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 233.88.
