DETAILS OF WORK

Due to non-commercial production this well will be plugged & abandoned in the following manner:

1. Spot a 631' cement plug from 6155-5524' to cover open hole (5574-6155').
2. Spot a 350' cement plug from 3450-3000' to cover perforated interval 3500-3764'.
3. Determine 7" casing free point and cut.
4. Spot a 100' cement plug across cut off, pull casing.
5. Spot a 21' cement plug with a 4" x 4' permanent dry hole marker in top of surface pipe.
6. Clean location.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
