DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Drill 15" hole to 200' set 10-3/4" O.D. casing at that point and cement with 150 cu. ft. gel. cement. Drill with mud to approximately 3500', set 7-5/8" O.D. casing and cement with 150 cu. ft. gel. cement. Drill with gas from 3500 to top of Mesa Verde at approximately 5200'; set 5-1/2" casing and cement with 150 cu. ft. gel. cement. then drill the Mesa Verde formation with gas, and sand from the Point Lookout and Cliff House separately with 10,000 gal. treatment, cement well, run 2-3/8" tubing and complete well.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

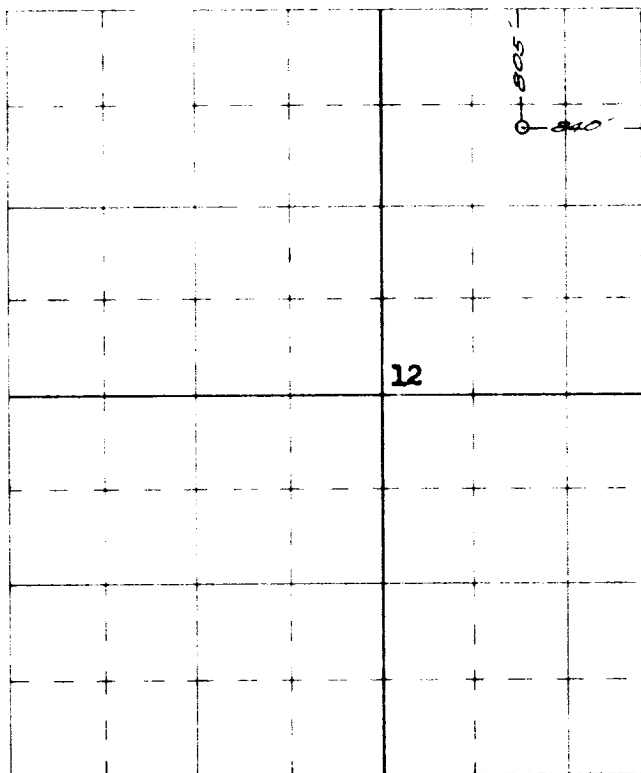
