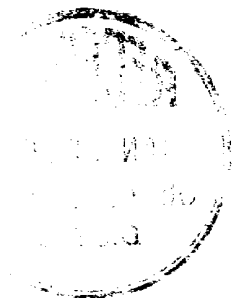

ORDER NO. DC-242

THE APPLICATION OF PACIFIC NORTHWEST PIPELINE CORPORATION FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS SAN JUAN UNIT 29-4, WELL NO. 7-8, LOCATED IN THE NW/4 NW/4 OF SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, NMPM, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN AN UNDESIGNATED MESAVERDE GAS POOL AND AN UNDESIGNATED PICTURED CLIFFS GAS POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-316, Rule 112-A, Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on September 22, 1955 for permission to dually complete its San Juan Unit 29-4 Well No. 7-8, located 820 feet from the north line and 1040 feet from the west line and in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 8, Township 29 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in an undesignated Mesaverde Gas Pool and an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool.

The Secretary-Director Finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, herein, Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation be and it hereby is authorized to dually complete its San Juan Unit 29-4, Well No. 7-8, located in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 8, Township 29 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such manner as to permit production of gas from the Mesaverde formation of an undesignated Mesaverde Gas Pool through the tubing by proper perforation of the casing and the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation of an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool through the casing-tubing annulus by the proper perforation of the casing and the installation of a suitable packer and with the installation of adequate surface equipment to maintain complete separation of the two zones of production.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That subject well shall be completed and thereafter produced in such a manner that there will be no commingling within the well-bore, either within or outside the casing, of gas, oil and gas, or oil produced from either or both of the separate strata,

PROVIDED FURTHER, That said subject well for dual completion and production shall be equipped in such a way that reservoir pressures may be determined separately for each of the two specified strata, and further, be equipped with all necessary connections required to permit recording meters to be installed and used, at any time, as may be required by the Commission or its representatives, in order that natural gas, oil, or oil and gas from each separate stratum may be accurately measured and the gas-oil ratio thereof determined, and

These provisions of Order No. 1-311, Rule 112-A, Pacific Northwest Electric Corporation were applicable to the ten service oil conservation contracts on the books of the corporation for permission to install complete the San Juan and 22-1 well no. 1-3, located 887 feet from the north line and 1014 feet from the west line in the NW 1/4 of Section 2, Township 2 North, Range 1 East, T12N, R10E, W10E, in the unincorporated Reservoir Gas Pool, and an underground drained oil gas pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
