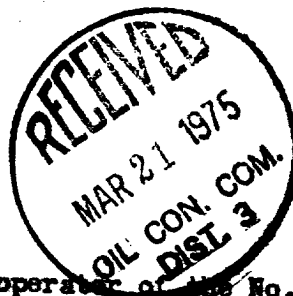

Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company is the operator of the No. 11 San Juan 29-4 Unit well, located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 6, T. 29 N., R. 4 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, on Federal oil and gas lease Santa Fe 079756. Said well was completed November 1, 1956, but has never been produced commercially. By Sundry Notice dated November 17, 1971, you advised that an investigation for a casing leak in the well was to be made. No results of this investigation have been reported.

Temporary abandonment of any well under jurisdiction of the U.S. Geological Survey must now receive formal approval. Such approval may be granted, for a period not to exceed one year, provided reasons for temporary abandonment are deemed adequate.

Please submit an original and four copies of Sundry Notice (form 9-331) requesting temporary abandonment for the above well. This request should set forth the present status, date of last production, reason for requesting temporary abandonment, and future plans for the well including approximate dates of planned workovers or plugging operations.
