This letter will confirm your conversation with Steve Cathey, of our Farmington office, concerning venting of gas on the Conoco operated well referenced above.

Conoco respectfully requests permission to vent gas thru the tank for this well which was drilled in 1973 and has never been connected to sales. After testing, we will evaluate and take action on the well. We feel that by venting the gas a possible fire hazard in the forrest is avoided and also the expense of digging a pit to flare.
