*Amended Administrative Order NSL-2837*

Dear Mr. Simmons:

Reference is made to your application dated June 14, 1991 to amend Division Administrative Order NSL-2837, dated July 30, 1990, which authorized Falcon's 29-4 Carson "19" Well No. 1 to be drilled at an unorthodox coal gas well location 2120 feet from the North line and 950 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 19, Township 29 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding as a result of a resurvey of the surface location, it was found that the actual location is 1910 feet from the North line and 655 feet from the East line (Unit H) of said Section 19.

Division Administrative Order NSL-2837 is hereby amended to reflect said location change. Further, all other provisions of said Order NSL-2837 shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
