Dear Mr. Arnold:

The 1960 packer leakage test has not been obtained on State No. 3 MV and State No. 3 PC dual completion in Section 32-29N-8W due to interference by the Hammond Ditch Project.

The test was scheduled from August 8th to September 6th. The test was broken on September 1st when Southern Union had to shut down their trunk to State 3 MV while work was proceeding on the Hammond Ditch. The wells have not been put back on production but they are scheduled to go on production next week. The packer leakage test will be secured as soon as the Mesaverde side of State No. 3 can be produced.

It is also requested that some consideration be given to makeup of allowable on State No. 2 and State No. 3 for the current proration period. The wells can make their allowable if they are allowed to produce. The July Redistribution Schedule shows a July net allowable after redistribution of 38,145 MCF for State No. 2 and 3,409 MCF for State No. 3. It would be appreciated if an exception can be made on these wells to prevent loss of allowable during the current proration period, if they do not fully make up their allowable by 2-1-61.

September and October production have been lost and at least ten days in November will be lost before the wells can go on production
