If dual completion authority has been given for this well, please advise this office of the order number. If no order has been issued, please so confirm and an order will be issued.

We also need to know whether the well is still equipped with $4\ 1/2$ -inch casing cemented at 7773 feet with 200 sacks, perforated at 4803-5339 feet in the Mesaverde and at 7402-7682 feet in the Dakota, and flowing through $2\ 3/8$ -inch tubing and through the $2\ 3/8$ -inch x $4\ 1/2$ -inch annulus with a packer at 7365.
