On 6-15-70 cut stuck tubing off at 4690', pulled tubing and set cement retainer at 4512'. Squeezed open hole w/150 sacks of cement.

On 6-16-70 located hole in 7" casing between 1684' and 1714', perforated 2 squeeze holes at 2309', set cement retainer at 2249', squeezed thru perfs w/125 sacks of cement.

On 6-17-70 located hole in 7" between 1553' and 1595', set cement retainer at 1562', squeezed leak w/125 sacks of cement.

On 6-19-70 Set cement retainer at 2220', re-squeezed perfs at 2309' w/250 sacks of cement.

On 6-23-70 ran 173 joints 4 1/2", 10.5" K casing (5594') set at 5604' w/125 sacks of cement. W. O. C. 18 hours.

On 6-24-70 P.B.T.D. 5589'. Perf. 5252-58', 5276-88', 5306-12', 5324-30', 5346-52', 5362-68', 5508-14' w/18 SPZ. Frac w/80,070 gal. water, 80,000# 20/40 sand, dropped 6 sets of 18 balls, flushed w/3700 gal. water. Displaced bridging ball to baffle at 5064' and tested to 3000 psi O. K. Perf. 4664-76', 4782-88', 4808-20' w/24 SPZ. frac w/25,850 gal. water, 27,500# 20/40 sand, dropped 1 set of 24 balls, no flush.

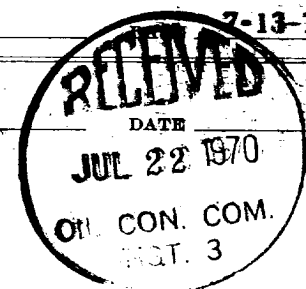

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 5: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material played below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
