THE APPLICATION OF ANDERSON-PRICHARD OIL CORPORATION FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS PRICHARD FEDERAL WELL NO. 1, LOCATED IN THE SW/4 NE/4 OF SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 8 WEST, NMPM, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BLANCO MESAVERDE POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE PICTURED CLIFFS FORMATION ADJACENT TO THE BLANCO PICTURED CLIFFS POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Anderson-Prichard Oil Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 24, 1958, for permission to dually complete its Prichard Federal Well No. 1, located in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 6, Township 29 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs Formation adjacent to the Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool.

Now on this 4th day of December, 1958, the Secretary-Director finds:

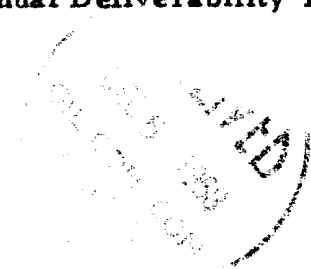
- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Anderson-Prichard Oil Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Prichard Federal Well No. 1, located in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 6, Township 29 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco Mesaverde Pool, and the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs Formation adjacent to the Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool, through the tubing and the casing-tubing annulus respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A, as amended by Order R-1214.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco Mesaverde Pool.

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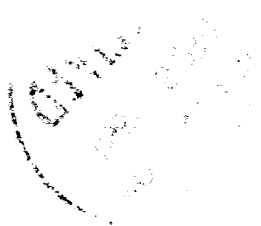
