We have received Gas Supplement No. (NW) 4944 dated September 3, 1959 covering supplemental allowable for months July through September of this year on the subject well. Evidently this supplement was issued due to workover and, in effect, changed the annual deliverability test to annual test after workover.

The last work performed on this well consisted only of dually completing the Mesaverde and Fictured Cliffs. No stimulation was given the Mesaverde section, only a change in the tubing string design resulted. Any effective change in deliverability or productivity of this well due to workover can be attributable only to the Fictured Cliffs zone which to date has not been connected to a pipe line.

For this reason we are requesting cancellation of your Gas Supplement No. (NW) 4944.
