4-17-73 PBDT 3533'. Tested casing; held 4000#. Perfed 3424-3434', 3444-3454 and 3464-3480' w/30 SPZ. Fraced w/30,000# 10/20 sand and 30,492 gallons treated water. Dropped two sets of 30 balls each. Flush w/656 gallons water.
