

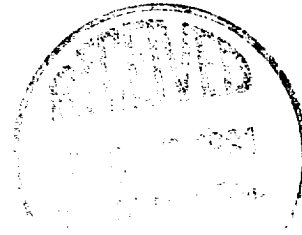

Gentlemen:

Attached in duplicate (to each office) are a well location plat C-102 with a sketch of the surrounding conditions and an ownership plat for the above captioned well.

The proposed site of the Roelofs Com 5 is 635 FSL, 715 FEL. This well has been relocated from an original position at 1180 FSL, 790 FEL because of the location of existing facilities and severe topographical features. Southland Royalty's Hill #3A is located 990 FSL, 790 FEL. A wide, deep canyon traverses the SE quarter of Section 10 as shown on the attached drawing.

A copy of this application is being submitted to all offset operators by certified mail with a request that they furnish your Santa Fe office with a waiver of objection.

Pursuant to authority of Rule 104-F we respectfully request your approval of an exemption to the standard well location requirements.

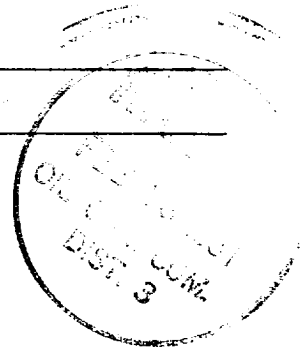

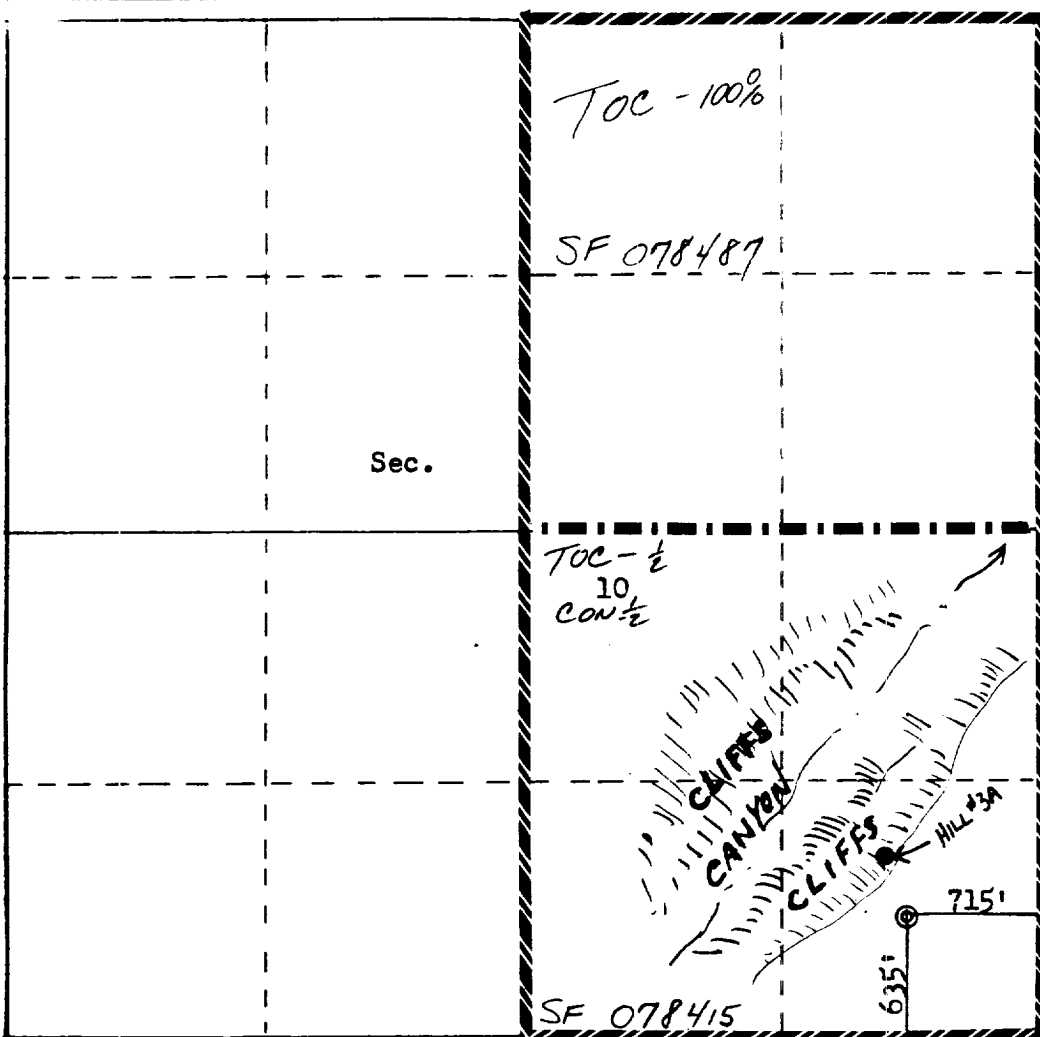

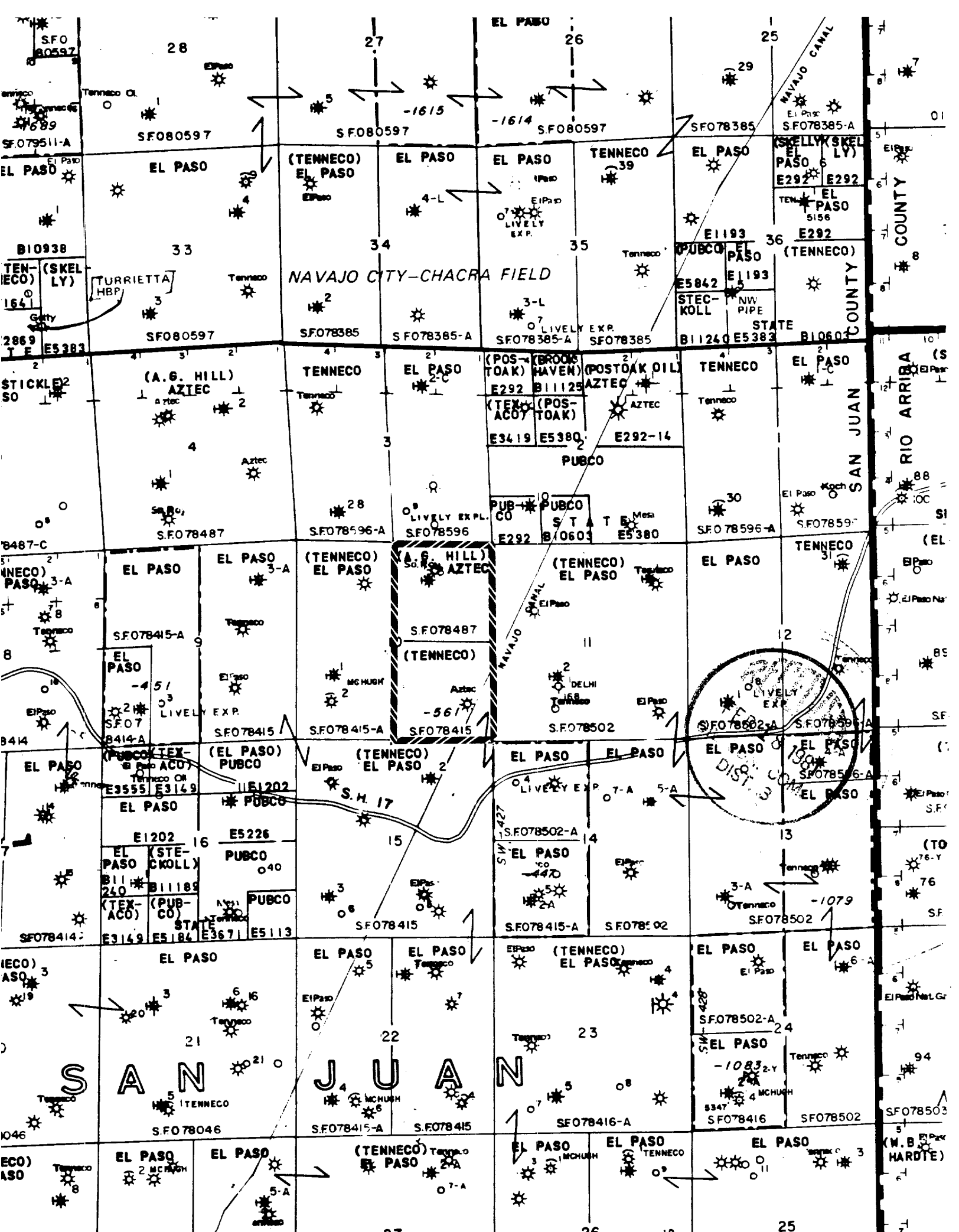
